Background Information

ETS1 is a member of the ETS family of transcription factors, which are defined by the presence of a conserved ETS DNA-binding domain that recognizes the core consensus DNA sequence GGAA/T in target genes. ETS1 is a nuclear protein and primarily acts as a transcriptional activator, though it can also repress gene transcription. Since it is primarily expressed in lymphocytes, it plays several critical roles in immunity. In addition, it is important for angiogenesis. Since cells express several Ets proteins at the same time, functional redundancy is possible. This is particularly shown for the so-called housekeeping genes where several Ets factors were found to occupy the proximal promoters in vivo. The ETS1 protein exists as three isoforms: ETS1-p51, ETS1-p42, ETS1-p27 ranging in size from 27 to 51 kDa.

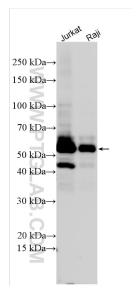

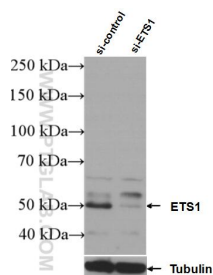

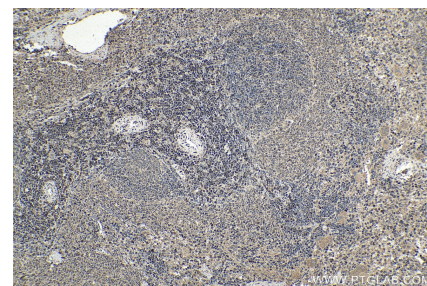

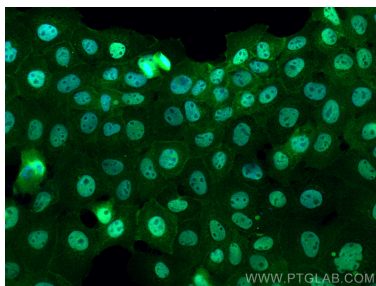

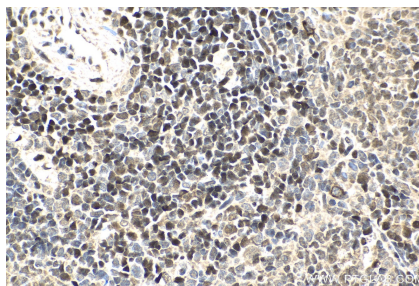
