Background Information

The mitochondrial F1Fo-ATP synthase complex uses energy derived from a proton gradient to synthesize ATP. The ATP5D gene encodes the delta subunit of the mitochondrial ATP synthase F1 complex and belongs to the ATPase epsilon chain family. This gene encodes the full length protein of 17 kDa with a transit peptide of 22 amino acid.

Storage

Storage:

Store at -20°C. Stable for one year after shipment.

Storage Buffer:

PBS with 0.1% sodium azide and 50% glycerol pH 7.3.

Aliquoting is unnecessary for -20°C storage

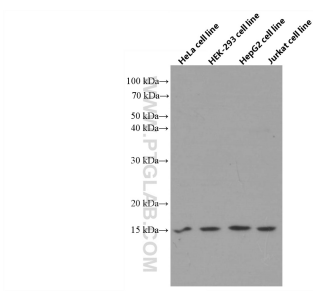

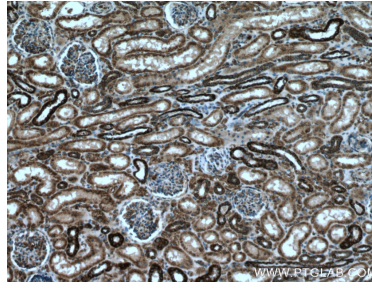

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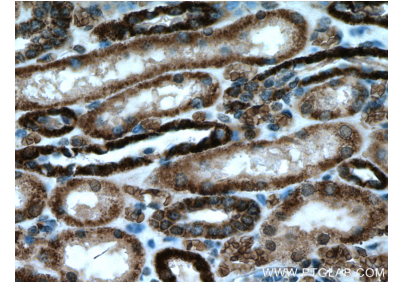
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 66673-1-Ig (ATP5D antibody) at dilution of 1:2000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours.
