Background Information

Catechol O-methyltransferase (COMT) is an important enzyme that catalyzes O-methylation and inactivation of metabolically active catechol-containing bioactive molecules and drugs. The mammalian COMT enzyme exists in soluble form (24-26 kDa) and membrane-bound form (28-30 kDa), which are encoded by a single gene utilizing different promoters.


Store at -20°C. Stable for one year after shipment.

PBS with 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol pH 7.3.



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 68181-1-Ig (COMT antibody) at dilution of 1:10000 and incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. The membrane was stripped and reblotted with HRP-conjugated GAPDH Monoclonal antibody (HRP-60004) as loading control.



Immunofluorescent analysis of (4% PFA) fixed mouse cerebellum tissue using COMT antibody (68181-1-lg, Clone: 1A1A4) at dilution of 1:400 and CoraLite® 488-Conjugated Goat Anti-Mouse IgG(H+L).
