Background Information	STK39 (Serine/Threonine Kinase 39) is a proline- and alanine-rich Ste20-related kinase (also named as SPAK), which is composed of a short N-terminal proline and alanine repeats (PAPA box), a kinase catalytic domain and a C- terminal regulatory domain (PMID: 16382158). In mammalians, STK39 plays an important role in ion homeostasis by regulating the cation chloride cotransporters' activities, which is crucial for the modulation of renal salt transport and blood pressure (PMID: 33500714). Notably, STK39 is also implicated in the regulation of tumor cell proliferation, migration, and invasion in multiple cancers, including osteosarcoma and cervical cancer (PMID: 34335956).
