Background Information

PLEKHB2, also named as EVT2 (Evectin-2), is involved in retrograde transport of recycling endosomes. PLEKHB2 has been identified as post-Golgi proteins of unknown function that have a PH domain that typically binds polyphosphoinositides. PLEKHB2 is expressed in a broad range of tissues. PLEKHB2 has some isoforms with MW 19-26 kDa and 34 kDa. This antibody recognizes all the isoforms of PLEKHB2.

Storage

Storage:
Store at -20°C. Stable for one year after shipment.
Storage Buffer:
PBS with 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol pH 7.3.
Aliquoting is unnecessary for -20°C storage



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 67877-1-Ig (PLEKHB2 antibody) at dilution of 1:5000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. The membrane was stripped and reblotted with HRP-conjugated GAPDH Monoclonal antibody (HRP-60004) as loading control.
