Background Information

IL-33 is an IL-1 family cytokine and nuclear alarmin, is constitutively expressed in epithelial barrier tissues and human blood vessels. IL-33 is involved in the maturation of Th2 cells and the activation of mast cells, basophils, eosinophils and natural killer cells. It also acts as a chemoattractant for Th2 cells, and may function as an "alarmin", that amplifies immune responses during tissue injury. IL-33 is synthesized as a 30 kDa full-length precursor that can be processed into an ~18-20 kDa mature form by inflammatory proteases, with the mature form exhibiting substantially higher biological activity as an extracellular alarmin cytokine.

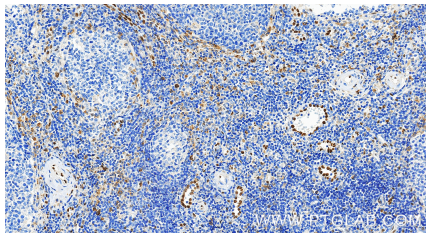

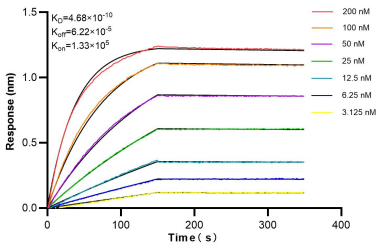
Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 83765-7-RR (IL-33 antibody) at dilution of 1:2200 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 83765-7-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human tonsillitis tissue slide using 83765-7-RR (IL-33 antibody) at dilution of 1:1000 (under 20x lens). Heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 9.0). This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 83765-7-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human tonsillitis tissue slide using 83765-7-RR (IL-33 antibody) at dilution of 1:1000 (under 20x lens).
