Background Information

STBD1 may have the capability to bind to carbohydrates. It functions as a glycogen receptor that tethers glycogen to autophagic membranes for delivery and breakdown in lysosomes. STBD1 appears molecular mass of 35-38 kDa band in mouse/rat tissues and 38-43 kDa in human tissue.

Storage

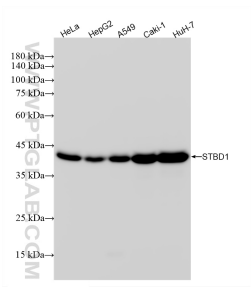
Storage:

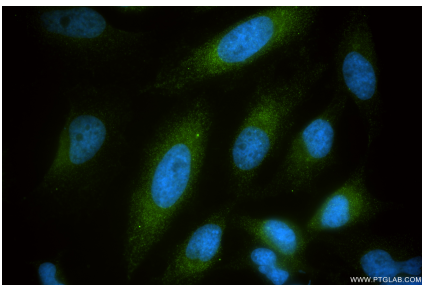

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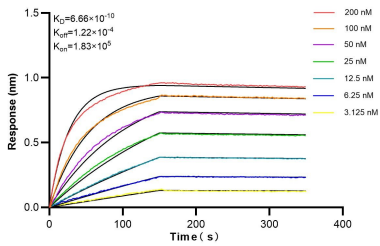
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 87526-1-RR (STBD1 antibody) at dilution of 1:5000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours.



Immunofluorescent analysis of (4% PFA) fixed HeLa cells using STBD1 antibody (87526-1-RR, Clone: 252915D10) at dilution of 1:200 and CoraLite® 488-Conjugated Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L) (SA00013-2).



Biolayer interferometry (BLI) kinetic assays of 87526-1-RR against Human STBD1 were performed. The affinity constant is 0.666 nM.
