Background Information

AP1B1 is a subunit of the adaptor complex AP-1 and is a member of the adaptin protein family. Adaptor protein (AP) complexes are cytosolic heterotetramers that mediate the sorting of membrane proteins in the secretory and endocytic pathways. AP-1 is found at the cytoplasmic face of coated vesicles located at the Golgi complex, where it mediates both the recruitment of clathrin to the membrane and the recognition of sorting signals within the cytosolic tails of transmembrane receptors. 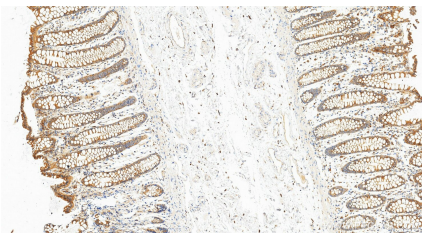

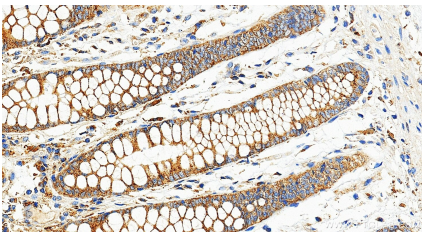

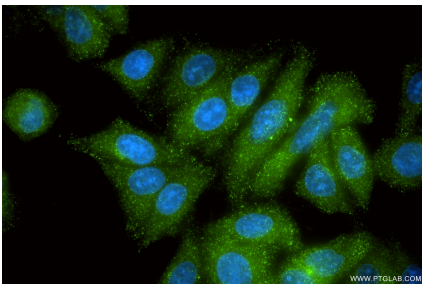
WB result of AP1B1 antibody (87859-1-RR; 1:3000; incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours) with sh-Control and sh-AP1B1 transfected HEK-293 cells. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 87859-1-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



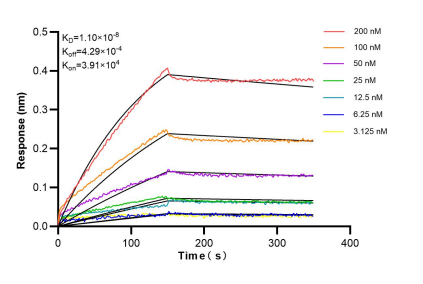

Heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 9.0). This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 87859-1-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



Immunofluorescent analysis of (-20°C Methanol) fixed HepG2 cells using AP1B1 antibody (87859-1-RR, Clone: 253524A11) at dilution of 1:200 and Coralite®488-Conjugated Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L) (SA00013-2). This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 87859-1-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



Biolayer interferometry (BLI) kinetic assays of 87859-1-RR against Human AP1B1 were performed. The affinity constant is 11.0 nM.
