## **Background Information**

Interferon gamma (IFN  $\gamma$ ), is a type II interferon that provides immunity against bacterial, viral and protozoan infections. In its active form, IFN  $\gamma$  is a glycosylated, non-covalently linked homodimer of 29-32 kDa subunits. It is produced by a number of immune cell types including natural killer cells, natural killer T cells, and effector lymphocyte T cells following antigenic and inflammatory triggers. The IFN  $\gamma$  dimer binds to its cognate receptor which has two subunits: IFN-y R1 which is the ligand-binding chain (a chain) and IFN-y R2, the signal-transducing chain ( $\beta$  chain). Binding to the receptor activates the JAK/STAT pathway which in turn activates IFN  $\gamma$  responsive genes. While IFN  $\gamma$  can inhibit viral replication, it also works as an immune-modulator and immune-stimulator by increasing surface expression of class I MHC proteins. (PMID: 19268625; 10688427)


Storage
