

	Storage: It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Until expiry date, -20°C to -80°C as lyophilized proteins. 3 months, -20°C to -80°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 		
	Shipping: The product is shipped at ambient temperature. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the recommended temperature.		
Reconstitution	Briefly centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstitute at 0.1-0.5 mg/mL in sterile water.		
Background	CD8b (T-cell surface glycoprotein CD8 beta chain) is an integral membrane glycoprotein that forms disulfide-linked heterodimers with CD8a (CD8 alpha chain). The CD8 alpha/beta heterodimer is the predominant CD8 complex expressed on the cell surface (PMID: 1534146; 2111591). CD8 is a transmembrane glycoprotein predominantly expressed on cytotoxic T cells and can also be found on natural killer cells, cortical thymocytes, and dendritic cells. CD8 serves as a co-receptor for the T cell receptor (TCR). Both CD8 and TCR recognize antigens displayed by an antigen presenting cell (APC) in the context of class I MHC molecules. CD8 plays a role in T cell development and activation of mature T cells.
