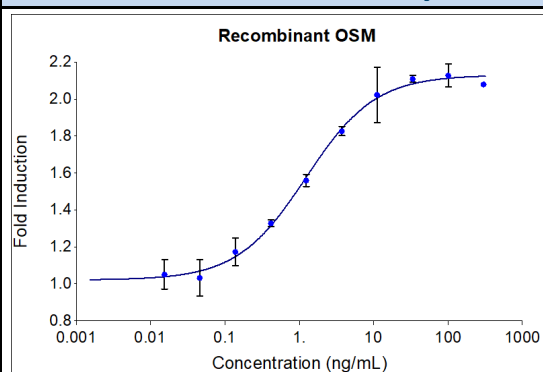
Animal-free Recombinant Human Oncostatin M is expressed in human 293 cells as a monomeric glycoprotein with an apparent molecular mass of 30 kDa. This higher molecular mass is due to glycosylation and is not seen in the E. coli expressed form of this cytokine (22kDa). Glycosylation contributes to stability in cell growth media and other applications. This product is produced in a human cell expression system with serum-free, chemically defined media.

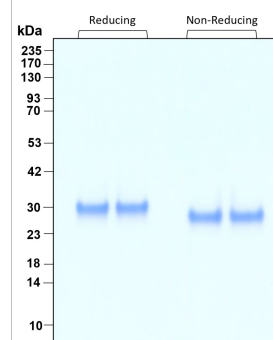

Recombinant human OSM (HZ-1030) stimulates dose-dependent proliferation of the TF-1 human erythroleukemic indicator cell line. Cell number was quantitatively assessed by PrestoBlue® Cell Viability Reagent. TF-1 cells were treated with increasing concentrations of GMP recombinant OSM for 96 hours. The EC50 was determined using a 4-parameter non-linear

Shipping Temperature	ambient temperature
Formulation	1x PBS, See Certificate of Analysis for details
Reconstitution	Briefly centrifuge the vial before opening. It is recommended to reconstitute the protein to 0.2 mg/mL in sterile 1x PBS pH 7.4 containing 0.1% endotoxin-free recombinant human serum albumin (HSA). Gently swirl or tap vial to mix.
