All the reagents are stored at 2-8°C. The kit is stable for 6 months from the date of receipt.


Background

Lymphocyte recirculation through different organs is thought to be regulated by adhesion molecules ("homing receptors") recognizing tissue-specific vascular addressins on endothelium. The mucosal vascular addressin, MAdCAM1, is an immunoglobulin superfamily adhesion receptor for lymphocytes that is expressed by mucosal venules and helps direct lymphocyte traffic into mucosal tissues including the Peyer patches and the intestinal lamina propria. MAdCAM1 can bind both integrin alpha-4/beta-7 and L-selectin, regulating both the passage and retention of leukocytes.




